

Passport to Paris 2017 Giveaway Contest

OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST.

OPEN ONLY TO LEGAL U.S. RESIDENTS WHO ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD AS OF THE DATE OF CONTEST ENTRY. VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.

By entering this Contest, entrants accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules. Any violation of these rules may, at Pittsburgh Post-Gazette's discretion, result in disqualification. All decisions of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette regarding this Contest are final and binding in all respects.

1. CONTEST DESCRIPTION

One winner will receive the grand prize of two roundtrip coach class tickets on Delta Air Lines from Pittsburgh to Paris and gift cards towards hotel accommodations for the hotel of your choice in the Passport to Paris 2017 Giveaway Contest (the "Contest"). To enter, complete an entry form online at www.post-gazette.com/paris during the Contest period. The Passport to Paris 2017 Giveaway Contest begins Sunday, March 5, 2017 at 12:01 AM EST and ends Friday, March 24, 2017 at 11:59 PM EST when all online entries must be received ("Contest Period"). **Entries received outside of the Contest Period will not be valid or accepted.**

2. WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PLAY

This sweepstakes (the "Contest") is only open to legal residents of the United States who are at least 18 years old as of the date of entry. Employees of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette, parent companies or subsidiaries, the Contest's participating sponsors and their advertising agencies, and members of the immediate family of any such persons are not eligible to participate and win. The term "immediate family" includes spouses, siblings, parents, children, grandparents, and grandchildren, whether as "in-laws," or by current or past marriage(s), remarriage(s), adoption, co-habitation or other family extension, and any other persons residing at the same household, whether or not related. 3. HOW TO ENTER CONTEST

Complete an entry form online at www.post-gazette.com/paris by the contest entry deadline of Friday, March 24, 2017 at 11:59 PM EST. Contestants can enter every day of the contest period to increase odds of winning.

Online limit: One entry per e-mail address per day during the Contest Period.

Entrant must (a) complete the entry form fully and accurately with all required information, (b) agree to these Official Rules, and (c) submit the completed entry form as outlined in these rules. By participating in the Contest, participants agree to receive information and offers from

Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and/or contest sponsors and affiliated partners for marketing and other purposes. You may unsubscribe at any time.

All entries become the property of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette and will not be acknowledged or returned. All entrant information, including email address, is subject to the respective Privacy Policy of the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette.

4. WINNER SELECTION

On or about Thursday, March 30, 2017, Sponsor will select one (1) potential grand prize winner via random drawing from among all eligible entries received. Odds of winning depend on number of eligible entries received. Purchase or acceptance of a product offer does not improve your chances of winning.

5. WINNER NOTIFICATION.

Potential Contest winners will be notified by phone and/or email. If, despite reasonable efforts, any potential Contest winner does not respond within 72 hours of the first notification attempt with potential winner's complete name and phone number and/or email as provided, such potential Contest winner may forfeit his or her prize and an alternate winner may be selected.

6. TAXES

All taxes (including, without limitation, federal, state, and local taxes) connected with any prize are the sole and exclusive responsibility of respective winners. The winner will receive a 1099 tax form at the end of the year for the full value of the prize amount based on the flight costs on the dates selected at the time of booking. 7. PRIZE

One (1) grand prize will be awarded. Prize includes two roundtrip coach class tickets on Delta Air Lines to Paris, France for two and \$1,500 in Visa gift cards toward hotel accommodations in Paris at the hotel of your choice. Prize will be given in the form of e-certificates for Delta Air Lines flights and gift cards for accommodations. Number of nights depends on winner's hotel selection and option to exceed gift card value at winner's expense.

8. AIR TRAVEL

Airline transportation will be awarded in the form of e-certificates that must be redeemed by March 1, 2018 and travel must take place between May 1, 2017 and May 1, 2018. Certificates may be redeemed for roundtrip coach class travel on Delta Air Lines from the winner's home gateway served by Delta Air Lines to Paris. Any transportation that is unclaimed, is not awarded or is otherwise not used by the travel completion date specified will be forfeited.

Certificate seats are subject to actual inventory availability. Certificates are non-transferable, are not redeemable for cash and are void if sold or bartered. Certificates used for international travel do not include U.S. International Air Transportation and U.S. and foreign user, inspection, security or other similarly based charges, fees or taxes, depending on itinerary. For travel to/from Europe there is a fee for second checked bag when bags are prepaid during online check-in at delta.com. There is an additional surcharge for the second bag, when checking in via ticket counter, kiosk, or curbside.

*Fees are EUR exit Europe Allowances subject to size/weight limits. These taxes and fees are subject to change, are the responsibility of the passenger and (except for bag fees) must be paid at the time the ticket is booked. Any taxes, fees, or changes paid at the time of ticket issuance will be refunded if ticket is not used. However, once redeemed, Certificates are void and will have no further value. Certificate travel will not qualify for SkyMiles mileage. Stopovers/Upgrades/Waitlisting/Open Returns are not permitted for tickets booked with Certificates.
