RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating in gun club or hunting activities, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence the Faribault Archery Club and its directors, officers, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

1. I acknowledge that archery club activities involve known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to, death or serious injury as a result of being shot or as a result of equipment malfunction; loss of vision; broken bones, bruises and other bodily injuries caused by falls; medical conditions resulting from physical activity, and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.
2. I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so solely in the state where Releasees' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release, and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. **I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.**

2018 Card Access Rules & Requirements

- The indoor range is to be available to all card access holders for archery related activities any time there is not a scheduled event in the months of September through May. This schedule may change slightly due to unforeseen circumstances. Consult FAC web site or posted range schedule for range availability. Times not available to card access holders include:
 - Monday nights 7 – 9, January – March (Animal league)
 - Saturday mornings 9 – 12pm, January – March (Kids instructional shoot)
 - NASP practices on Tuesday evenings and Sunday afternoons. While there may be room for members to shoot, NASP rules, procedures, and shooting lines will need to be followed by everyone during those times.
 - Tournaments/Shoots/Classes (times vary, consult schedule at range or web site)
- Card holders may not shoot at 3D targets that are set up for 3D shoots.
- The range will not be available to card access holders for the months of June, July & August. (FAC does not have exclusive rights of the building during these months.)
- You must comply with all range rules at all times.
- Please be aware that all access cards carry a unique access code. The access system will record all dates and times of access.
- Card access privileges are non-transferable. The only exception is immediate family members holding a family membership.
- Card access holders are not to let anyone else into the building regardless of whether they are card access holders or not.
- Report the names of anyone who is at the range during a non-scheduled event without card access to a board of director as soon as possible. If you are comfortable asking them to leave please do so.
- Anyone using card access under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult club member.
- If you come into the range and find things out of order note the time of day and contact a member of the board of directors as soon as possible.
- If you are a card access member and would like to bring a friend to the range you must get approval from a member of the board of directors first.

- Please turn off all lights when you are done shooting.
- FAC board of directors reserves the right to remove card access privileges from anyone for any reason not consistent with the intent of the purpose of the club. This includes, but is not limited to the guidelines listed in this document.
- Any rule violation will result in immediate removal of card access privileges until the incident is reviewed by the board of directors. Penalties for rules violations will be determined by the board of directors. Penalties can include (but are not limited to) removal of card access privileges and expulsion from the club.
- Heat will be kept low (approx. 60°) during non-scheduled event times. Do not adjust the thermostats! Wear warm clothing.
- If you lose your card, please notify a member of the board of director as soon as possible, to prevent misuse of lost card.
- If you lose your card, a replacement charge of \$20 will be incurred. If you find your lost card, hand in your replacement card and \$10 will be reimbursed.

Having card access to the FAC indoor range is a privileged benefit offered to all FAC members. Proper use of this privilege will show the community the responsible nature of those involved with FAC. Therefore card access should be treated as a coveted possession as a member our club. Any misuse of this benefit by any club member will affect all club members and will therefore be dealt with swiftly and conclusively. This includes but is not limited to expulsion from the club. Please treat this privilege with the respect it deserves.

By signing this document you acknowledge that you understand the terms and conditions as a card access member of the Faribault Archery Club and that you will abide by all rules stated above and posted range rules. All members under Family membership's over the age of 18 must sign below that have access for the use of key card.
