



## Bodewell Rosé of Pinot Noir

At Bodewell we put a premium on place. That's why we only source from the most interesting and unique appellations in the country, and it's why the proceeds of this wine go to Wine to Water as they help provide access to fresh drinking water for communities in need all around the world. This Pinot Noir, from Mendocino (the northern outpost of California winemaking), is not your typical Rosé grape. It's tricky to grow, but when it's at its best, it produces a wine with lively acidity, and strong notes of cherry. Despite the full flavor and zippy acidity, the fruit falls delicately on the palate. Incredibly drinkable, this vivacious Rosé is a true workhorse wine suited to almost any occasion.

### Varietal/Composition

100% Pinot Noir

### Winemaking

Short skin contact made a light pink hue, Provencal style. Stainless steel fermentation enhanced flavors of cherry, pomegranate, and a hint of earth. Cool fermentation retained fruit and blocked MLF. We kept bright acidity and bottled early to capture youthful yet complex character.

### Tasting

Bright cherry and strawberry mix with a lively acidity. Still delicate, the focused purity of fruit is elegant and refreshing with classic Pinot Noir characteristics: cherry, rose, mushrooms, and a mineral finish. Bone dry.
