Orange—Wolf Run Trail

1 mile loop to Wolf Run Lake

Purple—Bush Creek Trail

1 mile, shortest route to the Trail House (#11)

Blue—Prairie Trail

¾ mile to the prairie observation deck

Grey—Wetland Trail

1.3 mile loop from the bus stop (#13)

Red—Wildflower Trail

¾ mile connecting to the Meramec River

★ The Wilderness Wagon

stops at the Visitor Center, Trail House, and Bus Stop every 30 minutes.
