

# Baserock Instruction Manual

## Putting Baserock Core in the Baserock Pack

1. Unclip insert from controller



2. Place insert into special pocket behind the main compartment. It should fit snugly into the elastic straps, push it all the way down. Nothing else should go in this pocket.



3. Feed the wire through the right shoulder strap of the pack to the front.

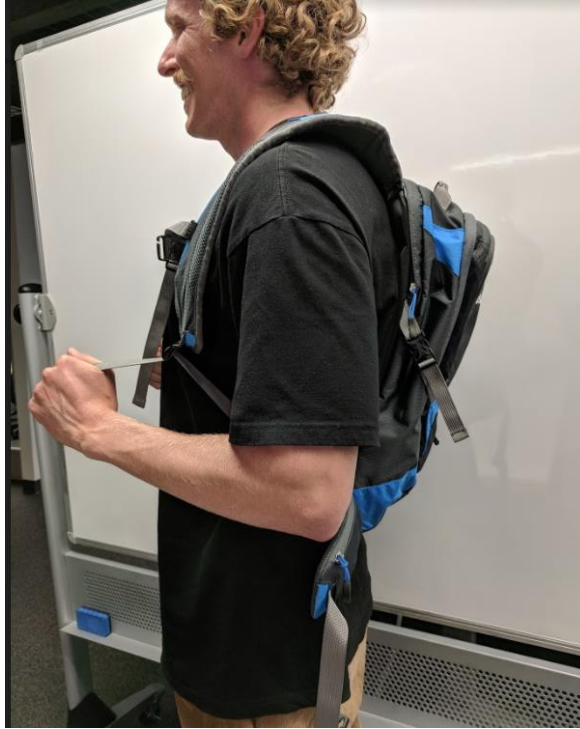


4. Connect the end of the wire to the controller. The controller can be completely zipped into the front shoulder pocket.



# Wearing the Baserock Pack

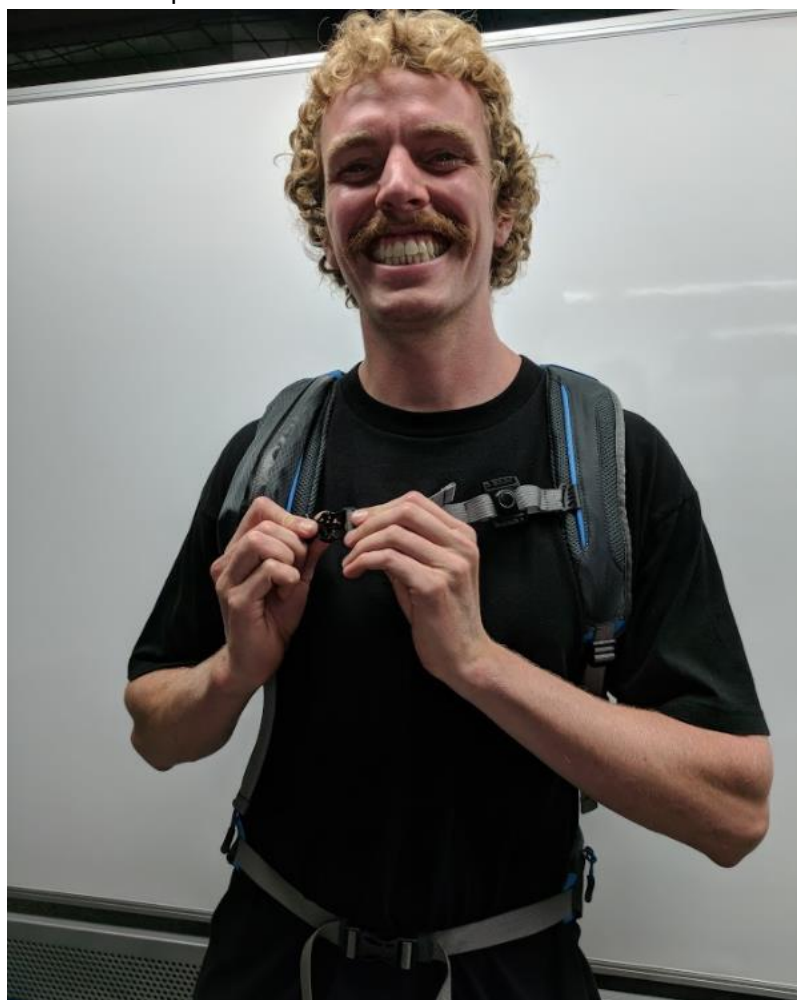
1. Place on backpack on shoulders.
2. Tighten the shoulder straps so the bottom of the backpack rests right above your hips.



3. Attach and tighten hip belt




4. Attach and tighten sternum strap



## Using with Auxiliary Input

Caution: Be careful blasting full volume, full intensity, bass heavy songs through Baserock. Like any audio device or speaker, it should not be overdriven.

1. Plug headphones into input labeled 
  - Note: You could also plug in any other device, such as a small portable speaker, that you want to listen from



2. Plug auxiliary cord into input labeled AUX



3. Plug other end of auxiliary cord into audio source, press play
4. Turn on by turning knob



5. Find desired intensity level:
  - First, set volume of headphones using the audio source (such as your phone). This will also affect the intensity of vibration from Baserock.
  - Second, find desired intensity level by turning knob. This will change intensity of vibrations from Baserock, but will not affect volume on headphones.

## Using with Live Music

1. Be in an environment with loud music. Baserock was designed to be used at a large concert or festival, however it may work with a nice set of speakers that has sizeable subwoofer.
2. Without anything plugged into auxiliary ports, turn on by turning knob



3. Knob controls intensity, but you may have to find the "sweet spot" for optimal use
  - On live mode, turning the intensity all the way up can cause Baserock to overreact. Find the proper intensity level for the volume of music.
  - Baserock likes to create awesome bass vibrations, so if it is quiet (in between a song, for example), it may start vibrating out of control. Just turn it down until the music starts back up!

## Charging

1. Plug charger into input labeled ⚡



2. Light will turn RED when charging
3. Light will turn off when finished charging
4. Baserock can not be used while charging



# Hydration Reservoir

1. Unwrap mouthpiece and clasp



2. Attach clasp to sternum strap



3. Place hydration reservoir into main pocket behind divider



4. Attach velcro loop to top of reservoir



5. Thread nozzle through top of main pocket
