Students **must** complete six of the following core papers:

- Academic skills for business
- Accounting Principles
- Introduction to Commercial Law
- Economic Environment
- Organisation and Management
- Fundamentals of Marketing
- Business Computing
- Business Communications

Core Elective Competency optional papers

Students may choose this paper or be required to take it if, at entry, they do not demonstrate the mathematical skills required for success in the programme.

- Statistics and Financial Mathematics for Business

Elective Papers

Students are required to select a minimum of three and up to five papers from the following.

- Accounting Practises
- Management Accounting
- Applied Management
- Leadership
- Operations Management
- Human Resource Management
- Marketing Research

Entry requirements:

- must be at least 16 years of age
- Domestic: 14 credits NCEA Level 1 numeracy and 50 credits at Level 2, with at least 12 credits in each of three approved subjects (minimum 8 approved literacy credits – 4 credits reading, 4 credits writing); or equivalent study/work experience
- International students English Entry Requirements equivalent to IELTS 5.5 (no band lower than 5.0)
