### **Junior Gifted Camp 3 in 1 (K1-K2)**

#### **Learning Objectives:**

- Master active listening skills (e.g. foundational Paraphrasing and summarizing skills)
- Be able to de-escalate situations
- Be more confident and assertive
- Be able to demonstrate leadership qualities

### **Classroom to Boardroom Espresso Senior Camp – Conversation and Interview Skills (P3-P4)**

#### **Learning Objectives:**

- Identify good and poor listening skills
- Master active listening skills  
(Paraphrasing, summarizing, clarifying, encouraging, listening for feelings)
- Understanding empathy, reframing and de-escalation
- Handle difficult conversations and practise positive confrontational techniques
- Understand types of questioning and practice effective questioning

### **Junior Olympiad Math & Science Camp (P1-P2)**

### **Creative Writing Camp (Junior/Senior)**
