It is expected that participants in this hackathon will foster an open, positive, and harassment-free community and that they will treat each other with respect and courtesy.

Please follow the guideline below in spirit and letter, and encourage others to behave according to the same principles and values.

Our Standards

Hackathon participants are:

- Using welcoming and inclusive language
- Being respectful of differing viewpoints and experiences
- Gracefully accepting constructive criticism
- Focusing on what is best for the community
- Showing empathy towards other community members

Examples of unacceptable behavior include:

- The use of sexualized language or imagery and unwelcome sexual attention or advances
- Trolling, insulting/derogatory comments, and personal or political attacks
- Public or private harassment
- Publishing others' private information, such as a physical or electronic address, without explicit permission
- Other conduct which could reasonably be considered inappropriate in a professional setting

Participating in this hackathon is a choice. Violation of this Code may lead to a temporary or permanent ban from this event and, depending on the violation, from our future events.
