VR headset

Pico G2 4K



One VR headset with all necessary content and applications installed.

The VR headset will arrive fully charged and switched off.

VR controller

Including spare battery.

The controller houses brand new batteries at full capacity for long life.*

The case also includes spare brand new batteries at full capacity alongside the controller.*

Pico G2 4K uses 2x AAA batteries.

*Cornerstone VR products shipped internationally will **not** contain batteries for the controllers due to laws surrounding the shipping of batteries.



Charging cable

USB-based charging cable.

A single USB charging cable can also be found inside the headset. Usually this will be the one that came with the headset, unused.

Pico G2 4K charges via **USB-C**.

A Multi-USB to Outlet charging block will be provided for charging multiple headsets at once.



Headphones

Wired headphones via 3.5mm headphone jack.

The headphones are essential to immersion in VR.

While any pair of headphones with a standard 3.5mm jack connector will work with these VR headsets, it is best to use our provided compact headphones that can fold to ensure easy storage and a better fit in the Cornerstone case.

VR lens cleaning cloth

Microfibre cloth for cleaning VR headset lenses.



One microfibre cloth is included with every new VR headset, inside a plastic sleeve.

It is best practice to keep these cloths inside the plastic sleeve until they are needed to ensure they are completely clean upon first use, and return them to the plastic sleeve to keep dust away.

VR user guide

A guide for basic use and troubleshooting advice.

The VR headset user guides are essential as they contain information on how to use the device and some basic troubleshooting steps if errors occur. This guide may be changed and/or updated over time as new issues and fixes are discovered, so be sure to download the latest version of each guide on the resource portal/partners portal.

Antibacterial wipes

For cleaning a headset safely and thoroughly.

These antibacterial wipes are to be used in conjunction with the cleaning guide included in every Cornerstone case.

Three wipe sachets are included in every case, additional wipes will need to be supplied by the user. Any antibacterial sanitising wipe will suffice.

First use evaluation forms

To be completed by the user following headset use in a session.



Five copies of the 'First Use' evaluation forms are included in each Cornerstone case. These evaluation forms help us gather information on how our content is being used and the efficacy of VR for various functions and session types.

More of these forms can be printed if required.

Packing contents

Fitting the contents into the case comfortably.

In the top section, all of the documents (user guide, cleaning guide, first use evaluations, notebook and postcard) sit comfortably behind the net. This is also the ideal section for the lens cleaning cloth, and USB charging cable.

The bottom section houses the VR headset, the VR controller, the spare battery and the folded headphones. The folded headphones sit nicely tucked against the VR headset (inside the lens area), with the headphone curve lining up with the curve of the VR headset face pad.
