Dear Parent/Carer,

It is with great delight that I'm able to update you that an agreement, subject to planning permission, has been made to build four additional classrooms and associate facilities at Teynham. This development will enable the school to work from one site and enable all to consistently access the nurturing environment and facilities offered at Teynham.

The ISP school currently operates across two school sites one in Sittingbourne, and the other in Teynham. We are aware that the Sittingbourne site, despite considerable investment, doesn't provide the best learning environment for our pupils. However, as a result of a lack of classroom space currently at Teynham it is necessary for our pupils and staff to travel and work across both sites. All pupils at the Sittingbourne site currently access some of their learning at the Teynham site. They are frequently and regularly transported between the two sites and considerable learning time is lost.

It is hoped that we will be able to move into the new classrooms in September 2018. Logistics such as transport will be resolved prior to any move. This is an exciting development for the school.
