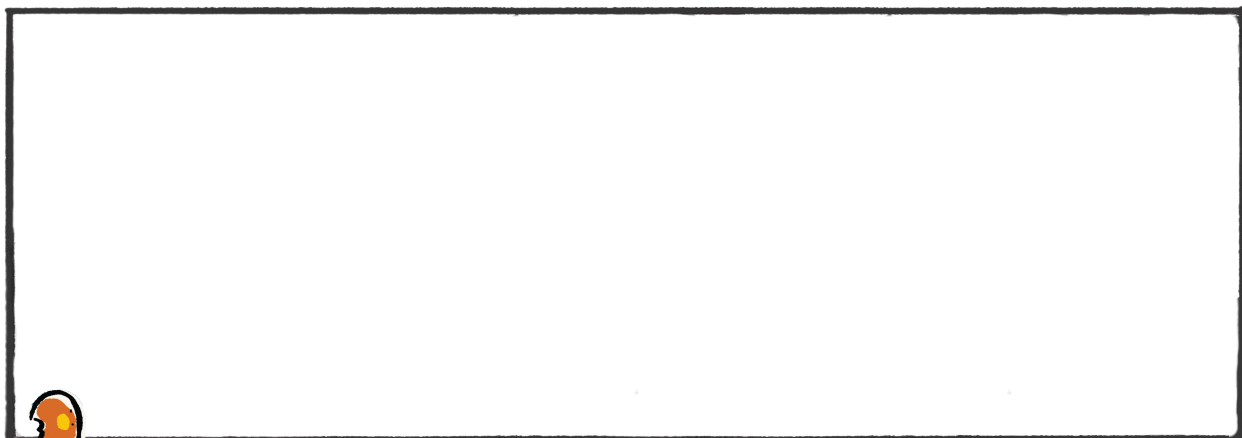
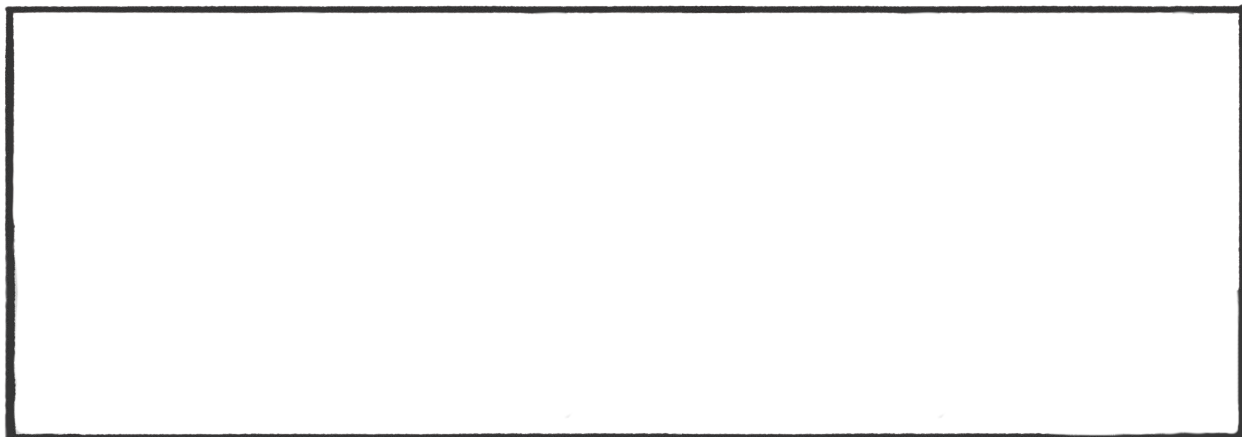
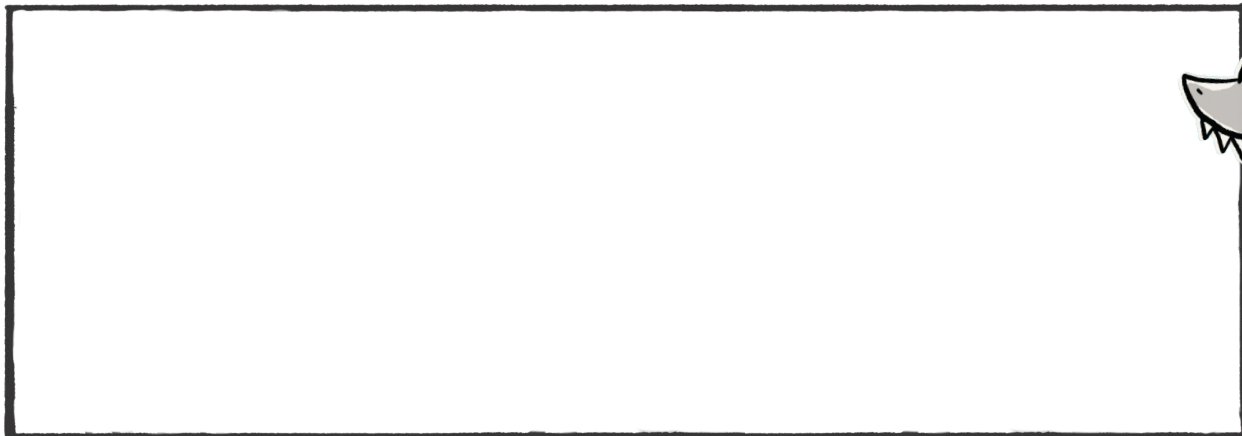


CREATE-YOUR-OWN GRAPHIC NOVEL ADVENTURE
