What to expect in the exam

You will be expected to conduct research based on a pre-released theme. During the exam you will be required to construct answers to previously unseen questions during a closed book 2 hour exam. We will provide the topic theme one calendar month prior to the exam.

What the examiner expects

You are required to demonstrate an understanding of the changing needs and requirements that an organisation expects from their Procurement and Supply function, what these requirements are, and what the challenges and opportunities might mean to the profession.
