Not only can LandAjob refer a steady stream of individuals for your agency to assist, but can also provide support services once your case is successfully closed.

Best of yet, our services are free to both the Vocational Rehabilitation Agency and the beneficiary.

Services to Your Beneficiaries


Once a case is closed, LandAjob provides Ticket to Work holder supportive services such as:

- Benefits counseling
- Career resources and employment maintenance advice
- Guidance in the areas of self-disclosure and reasonable accommodation
- Access to legitimate work opportunities

A key benefit for LandAjob recipients are job-expense reimbursements up to \$13,000. Reimbursements are distributed over a 3 to 5-year period allowing for an individual to successfully transition back into the workplace while achieving self-sufficiency.

Reimbursements include things such as transportation, daycare, some medications not covered by insurance.

More than \$1 million has been reimbursed to Ticket to Work beneficiaries and through our partnership, that number will grow.


LandAjob: Collaborating with Your Vocational Rehabilitation Agency
