HALF DAY TOURS DISCOVER BANFF & ITS WILDLIFE

8:15am Departure | 3 Hour Duration | All Ages Adult (13+) \$72 | Child (6-12) \$42 | Infant Free

On this tour, you will Build a connection to our World Heritage Site as you visit all of Banff's **key sightseeing landmarks**, learn its **history** and view **wildlife** in their natural summer habitat.

The tour will include some of the most scenic and historically significant **highlights of Banff** such as the Banff Springs Hotel, Bow Falls, Surprise Corner Lookout, Hoodoos Viewpoint and Lake Minnewanka. While watching for wildlife your guide will share stories about their behaviours, habitat and National Park initiatives to protect all **animals big and small**. Be ready with your camera for deer, elk, mountain goats, and even the occasional bear.



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DISCOVER LAKE LOUISE & MORAINE LAKE

7:45am & 12:45pm Departure | 4.25 Hours Duration | All Ages Adult (13+) \$90 | Child (6-12) \$45 | Infant Free

These stunning alpine lakes look too beautiful to be real. On this sightseeing tour you will visit the "Jewel of the Canadian Rockies", Lake Louise, and the world renowned Moraine Lake, both of which are part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site because of their priceless natural beauty. They'll stop you in your tracks in awe.

Wander the shoreline at Lake Louise and see the Victoria Glacier and the famous Chateau Lake Louise Hotel, and then snap some shots of Moraine Lake in the beautiful **Valley Of The Ten Peaks**. Join your guide for a short walk up the Rockpile at Moraine Lake, where you'll find the iconic view that was once on the back of the Canadian \$20 bill. During the tour your guide will weave tales of the early mountaineers, who also fell in love with this spot in the 189Os.

This tour is great way to avoid parking headaches, with parking lots often filling up by sunrise, get **guaranteed access** to both famous lakes on this guided tour.

EVENING WILDLIFE SAFARI

Departures vary seasonally (5:15pm, 6:15pm, 7:15pm) 2 Hours Duration | All Ages

Wildlife can be seen on most tours in Banff, although the evening wildlife safari is one of the best. This tour operates as the **sun sets** on the Bow Valley, when animals come out to play! The route of this tour changes depending on animal activity and has a **95% sighting rate**. Your guide will lead a paved road bus tour to the hotspots where you are most likely to see Rocky Mountain creatures. You might spot an elk sauntering across a clearing, bighorn sheep grazing in an alpine meadow and sometimes even a grizzly bear snuffling through a berry bush. You'll also learn about **how the park protects these animals** and their natural habitats from many threats to the ecosystem.







COLUMBIA ICEFILD DISCOVERY

No trip to the Canadian Rockies is complete without visiting the stunning **Columbia Icefield Centre**. The Icefield Parkway is largely considered one of the top scenic drives in the world. Two tour options available, offering alternate stops:

The first takes you from Banff to Lake Louise, where you will have time for photos at the lakeshore. Continuing on you will see the majestic sights the lcefields have to offer, from the surrounding glaciers to turquoise lakes. Keep your eyes peeled for wildlife on road such as big horn sheep, elk, deer, mountain goats, black bears & grizzly bears. The next stop will take you to **Bow Lake** where you will have time along the lakeshore to take in the **Crowfoot Glacier and Bow Glacier Falls** in the distance. Once at the Columbia lcefields field Centre, you will enjoy a tour on a **massive all-terrain vehicle** that will take you out onto the Athabasca Glacier. Then, after a **hot lunch**, step out onto the glass-floored platform of the Columbia lcefield **Skywalk**. Mountain adventure at its finest!

The second tour option offers all of the same views but switches your stop in Lake Louise for **Peyto Lake & Bow Summit Viewpoint**. Peyto Lake is the most visited and photographed lakes in the Canadian Rockies. During the summer, significant amounts of glacial rock flour flow into the lake, giving the lake a bright, turquoise colour. Bow Summit is the highest point on the Icefield Parkway and is the highest elevation crossed by a public road in Canada at 2,088m.

*Choosing to drive yourself is a great option if you are looking to get the most out of your day. FULL DAY TOURSMOUNTAINS LAKES & WATERFALLS

8:15am Departure | 9.5 Hours Duration | All Ages Adult (16+) \$184 | Child (6-15) \$92 | Infant Free

One of the most popular full day tours, exploring Lake Louise and Yoho National Park. Soaring mountains, stunning lakes and breathtaking waterfalls await you on a tour that explores the stunning lakes and streams of the Canadian Rocky Mountains.

From the history of the Canadian railroad to **Takakkaw Falls** (the second-highest waterfall in Canada!), follow the trails through a park whose name means "awe" in the Cree language. Explore the evolution of the land and discover how it has shaped the appearance of the natural wonders found in these spectacular mountain settings as you visit highlights such as Lake Louise, Moraine Lake, Emerald Lake, the Spiral Tunnels and Takakkaw Falls. With a delicious **hot lunch provided** at Emerald Lake Lodge.



ATHABASCA GLACIER ICEWALK

Explore the Columbia Icefield on foot! Ice Walks offer an **interpretive guided hike** on the Athabasca Glacier, taking you to parts of the glacier that you would otherwise be unable to experience. Learn about different glacier formation and view some spectacular **ice carved landscapes**. Three different glacial tours are available:

ICE CUBED | 3 - 4 Hours Duration Adult (17+) \$110 | Child (Age 10-16) \$60

Tour explores the lower half of the Athabasca Glacier and offers superb views of glacial features, ice carved landscapes and other alpine glaciers. Throughout the trip, short stops are made to introduce the concepts of active glaciation and features of a glacially carved landscape.

ICEWALK IN THE AFTERNOON | 3 Hours Duration Adult (17+) \$110 | Child (Age 10-16) \$60

Tour explores the lower two kilometres of the Athabasca Glacier. Throughout the trip, short stops are made to introduce the **concepts of active glaciation** and features of a glacially carved landscape.

ICEWALK DELUXE | 5 - 6 Hours Duration Adult (17+) \$175 | Child (Age 10-16) \$90

Tour explores the **entire length of the Athabasca Glacier**, usually culminating in an ascent to the lowest of three icefalls. Going into some of the most rugged sections of the glacier, this hike is guaranteed to take your breath away!





DISCOVER GRIZZLY BEARS

8:15am Departure | 10 Hours Duration | All Ages Adult (13+) \$237 | Child (6-12) \$115 | Infant Free

As you embark on the Grizzly Bear Tour, you will experience some amazing scenery **Yoho National Park** has to offer, such as The Spiral Tunnels, Takakkaw Falls, Emerald Lake and Kicking Horse Pass. You will arrive at Kicking Horse Mountain Resort and visit their **Grizzly Bear Refuge**.

The main event of the tour is **Boo**, a bear with paws the size of hubcaps, a mouth full of sharp teeth and enormous muscles moving beneath his shaggy fur. He saunters slowly through his 2O-acre habitat in the Rocky Mountain bush, allowing you to watch him explore, hunt and forage just like his wild cousins. You'll also hear **his personal story** and learn about grizzly bear behaviour during your visit to the largest enclosed grizzly bear habitat in the world.

*This tour promises a guaranteed grizzly bear sighting or your next tour is free.

You will also take a gondola ride up to the top of Kicking Horse Mountain Resort, where you'll enjoy **lunch** with a view at the **highest restaurant in Canada**.

GUIDED SIGNATURE HIKES

7:45am Departure | 7 Hours Duration | 13+ | \$111 per person

An excellent way of exploring the backcountry of Banff National Park. From the explosion of wildflowers in the spring, to the clear glacier views in the summer, to the brilliant golden of the larch trees in the fall, hiking in the Rockies should not be missed.

Your Interpretive Guides' priority is having a safe, fun & informative tour that **connects you** to where you are visiting. To reduce wildlife encounters tours consist of small groups for safety. Hiking time is between 4 - 6 hours, which includes an alpine picnic lunch. Sturdy footwear is required and we recommend dressing in layers to adapt to changes in weather.

HELI HIKING & HELI YOGA

Offering a way to see a part of the Rockies that would normally be inaccessible. Join a knowledgeable guide on an exhilarating helicopter flight that is sure to sweep you over some of the most stunning mountain scenery in the world. Get dropped off in the alpine, far from any other hikers for a private trek through the wilderness.

This guided ride takes you from Banff along the iconic **Bow Valley** Parkway to Johnston Canyon. Once there, à la carte lunch is provided and you have time on your own to explore the canyon, before riding together back to Banff.
