What is a two-term programme?

- Designed for students with a higher level of English.

What visa do I need?

If you intend to study a two-term programme at one of our university partners, we recommend that you apply for a Student Tier 4 visa, for which you must have an IELTS for UKVI.

If you intend to study a two-term programme at INTO London or INTO Manchester, we recommend that you apply for a Short-Term Study Visa (STSV). With a STSV, INTO is able to accept a wider range of English language qualifications as evidence that you meet the minimum requirements of the programme.*

*If you apply for a STSV, you will need to return to your home country in order to apply for your Tier 4 visa to allow you to study your degree programme.
