



Koch Accounting Apprenticeship Program

The Vision: To provide an opportunity for people from any background with natural aptitudes and interest in accounting or tax to participate in an accelerated, 18-month education process in Wichita that could result in full-time employment as a staff accountant or tax analyst at Koch companies.

The Candidate:

- Will gain hands-on, applied learning experience in the field of accounting and tax
- Receive a Technical Accounting Certificate from WSU Tech upon completion of the program
- Be considered for full-time employment at one of the Koch companies

Koch:

- Will cover Koch-sponsored foundational coursework offered through WSU Tech and Koch U
- Compensate the candidate throughout their apprenticeship employment up to \$24 an hour
- Provide the opportunity for full-time employment upon completion of the program in one of the Koch companies

Eligibility:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Able to work in the U.S. without sponsorship
- Able to meet the demands of a full-time student and ability to be enrolled in the WSU Tech Accounting Certificate Program
- Availability to work 20-25 hours during apprenticeship placement with intent to pursue full-time employment upon completion of the apprenticeship

Steps to Apply:

1. Apply for the Koch Accounting Apprenticeship [HERE](#) before September 27th
2. Attend the Koch Accounting Apprenticeship program interview October 18th or 19th
3. Upon acceptance into the program, complete application for admission to WSU Tech
4. Contact your WSU Tech Advisor and enroll for classes beginning in January 2023
