Can COVID-19 vaccines make it hard for us to get pregnant?

There is no evidence that COVID-19 vaccines cause problems when trying to get pregnant in women or men.

Do the COVID-19 vaccines affect women's periods?

Women may see temporary changes in their periods after getting COVID-19 vaccines, including:

- Longer times of bleeding
- Shorter times between periods
- Heavier bleeding than usual

Can COVID-19 vaccines affect men's sperm?

There is no evidence that fever after receiving the COVID-19 vaccine directly affects sperm production.
