Don't Know If You Should Get the Flu Vaccine?

Here Are a Few Items to Consider:

- Most people get better from the flu without problems, but the flu can be deadly. It can lead to serious health problems such as pneumonia, or it can make an existing disease worse.
- A flu vaccine may not always keep you from getting the seasonal flu, but it can make the symptoms milder and lower the risk of other health problems from the flu.
- The CDC recommends that everyone age 6 months and older should get a flu vaccine, especially those at high risk including young children, pregnant women, older adults, and people who have chronic diseases or weak immune systems.
