# ITINERARY

## Day 1: Friday, April 24, 2026

### DEPART FOR ISRAEL FROM USA

## Day 2: Saturday, April 25, 2026

### ARRIVAL IN THE LAND OF PROMISE

We arrive at Ben Gurion Airport near **Tel Aviv**, where we will be met by our guide and bus driver for the trip.

Overnight: Grand Beach, Tel Aviv



## Day 3: Sunday, April 26, 2026

### OLD JAFFA & MEGIDDO

Our first stop will be the ancient port of **Jaffa**, the point from which Jonah tried to escape his calling to warn the people of Nineveh and the location of Simon the Tanner's house. We continue our day at the fabulous ruins of the Herodian city of **Caesarea Maritima**, the site of the conversion of Cornelius and the location from which Paul left the shores of Israel and set sail on his journey to Rome. Later in the day we will have an opportunity to relax on one of the Mediterranean Sea beaches.

## Day 4: Monday, April 27, 2026

### CAESAREA MARITIMA & NAZARETH

We continue to ancient **Nazareth**, Jesus' boyhood home and place of His early ministry. We conclude our day at **Nazareth Village**, an open air museum in Nazareth recreating a first-century farm and village during the time of Jesus. Visit Rivka Sims (Gerad will arrange).

## Day 5: Tuesday, April 28, 2026

### NORTHERN ISRAEL – “Who Do Men Say That I Am?”

Our first stop is the **Dan Nature Reserve**, where we see the incredible archaeological remains of the **OT city of Dan**, including the city gate from the time of Abraham, and consider ancient Israel's apostasy. We will also enjoy a pleasant walk by a stream. Our next stop is **Caesarea Philippi**, in the region where Peter made his famous confession that Jesus is the Messiah.

## Day 6: Wednesday, April 29, 2026

### AROUND THE SEA OF GALILEE – Daily Life and Religion in the Time of Jesus

Today we start at **Mt. Arbel**, where an easy stroll brings us to panoramic views over the Sea of Galilee. **Mt. of Beatitudes**. After a short drive we will arrive at **Capernaum**, the town where Jesus lived during the majority of His ministry. From here we continue to **Chorazin**, the well-preserved ruins of a typical Galilean village, where we study village life, Jewish religion, and the Pharisees. Time permitting, we will also visit a possible location of **Bethsaida** found in Mark 8:22-26. Later in the afternoon we will visit Kibbutz Ginosar to see the “**Jesus Boat**”, a Galilean fishing boat from the First Century. From here we will set sail for a **boat ride on the Lake** to enjoy the views and some worship, prayer and reflective time. We will also visit **Magdala**, a first century Jewish town, the hometown of Mary Magdalene.

## Day 7: Thursday, April 30, 2026

### THE JORDAN VALLEY

Today we will visit **Ma'ayan Harod National Park** where **Gideon's Spring** is located. This is the spring where Gideon and his troops camped before their battle with the Midianites. Our next stop of the day will be the Biblical city of **Beit Shean** to examine the visually impressive excavations of its Roman-Byzantine period when it was one of the ten Hellenistic cities of the Decapolis. We will also be passing by the region of **Jericho** – the oldest and lowest city on earth. From here, we will continue to **Qumran**, likely the home of the Essenes, a First Century Jewish sect which may have influenced early Christianity, and the site of the most exciting archaeological discovery ever made in Israel – the Dead Sea Scrolls. We will finish our afternoon by enjoying a float in the therapeutic mineral rich waters of the Dead Sea.

## Day 8: Friday, May 1, 2026

### THE JUDEAN DESERT- Seeking Refuge in the Wilderness

Our theme today is the wilderness and what it signified to the ancient Israelites. We begin our day at **Masada**, Herod the Great's magnificent fortress palace in the desert, and the last stand of the Zealots, a Jewish revolutionary group at the time of Jesus. After, we visit the beautiful subtropical oasis of **Ein Gedi**, where David hid from Saul. Depending on conditions, we can walk into the nature reserve and possibly to the waterfalls. We may see some wildlife, including the fury rock badger and the graceful ibex. We will also discuss the temptation of Jesus in the Wilderness. We will also take the drive to **Bethlehem**, where we will visit the **Church of the Nativity**, which marks the probable site of the birth of Jesus, and the “**Shepherd's Fields**” where the angels heralded the advent of Messiah.

## Day 9: Saturday, May 2, 2026

### JERUSALEM IN THE TIME OF JESUS

#### IN THE STEPS OF JESUS – Crucifixion, Death, Burial and Resurrection

We start our day at a panoramic overlook of Jerusalem from the **Mount of Olives**, the site of Jesus' ascension to heaven and His future second coming. After viewing a **tomb from the time of Jesus**, we will walk down the Mount of Olives to **Gethsemane**. Next, we cross the **Kidron Valley** and enter the Old City through **Stephen's Gate**, stopping to examine the remains of the **Pool of Bethesda**. From here we walk to the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**, the most likely site of the burial and resurrection of Jesus. We end our day with a reflective time at a site that wonderfully illustrates Jesus' burial and resurrection, the peaceful **Garden Tomb**.

## Day 10: Sunday, May 3, 2026

We start our day at the **Western Wall** place of prayer, Judaism's most holy site. We will continue to the excavations near the base of the Temple Mount and discuss Pentecost on the **Southern Steps** where Jesus walked. From here we continue to the place where it all began – the **City of David**. Here we will learn about King David's conquest of the Jebusite city, and walk through **Hezekiah's Tunnel** to the **Pool of Siloam**.

## Day 11: Monday, May 4, 2026

### THE RESTORATION OF HOPE – A Garland Instead of Ashes

#### BEIT GUVRIN

We start at **Yad VaShem**, the Israel Memorial Museum to the Holocaust. Here we examine the spiritual and theological roots of the most notorious genocide in history and the connection between the Church, Jesus and the Jewish people. We will continue to **Beit Guvrin, Dig for a day**: The Dig for a Day program runs three hours. The activity includes: digging, sifting, pottery examination and touring the National Park of Beit Guvrin with an exciting crawl through unexcavated cave systems. Time permitting: **Israel Museum**.
