Varietal/Composition

100% Pinot Noir

Winemaking

A blend of three clones that are 100% destemmed with a 3-5 day cold soak and 20 day fermentation. Lightly pressed with moderate extraction, this wine settled for two weeks before racking off the heavy lees.

Tasting

Red fruits abound with raspberry, cranberry, and pomegranate and are supported by fine-grained tannins. The medium plus crisp acidity plays beautifully off the savory, earthy finish.
