OVERVIEW

What's a print room?

It can be any room with 1 or more MFDs production printers or both and can be referred to as a central reprographics department (CRD). Jobs are submitted to the room and attended to by someone other than the person who submitted the job.

What's a FabLab?

They can be a room with a few 3D printers, or it may have upward of 20. They can also contain computer numerical control (CNC) and laser cutting machines. These labs offer rapid prototyping fabrication in many education environments.
