

Reconstruct is an independent organisation and is NOT part of social services.

An advocate is a friendly person who can help you to get your voice heard.

An advocate:

- · Can speak to you on the phone or come and see you.
- They can help you have your say in your meetings and make sure people listen to you and take you seriously.
- They can help you prepare what you would like to say and sometimes they can 'say' it for you.
- They can help you if you think things aren't being done.
- They can help you if you want to make a complaint
- They can sit with you and support you in meetings, ask questions and explain difficult words and let you understand what is happening.
- · They can write letters and make phone calls and find things out.
- · Advocates can help you to be listened to and to be taken seriously.
