Chart of CEBOT Top Tech Companies

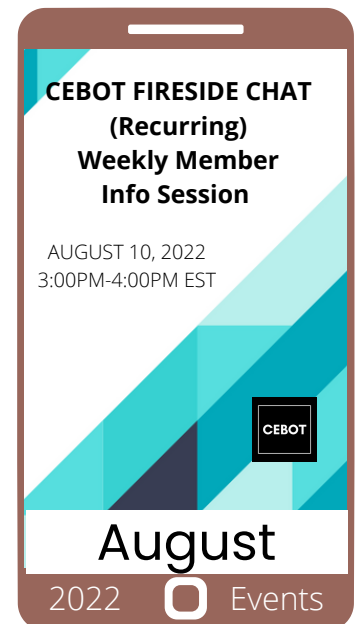
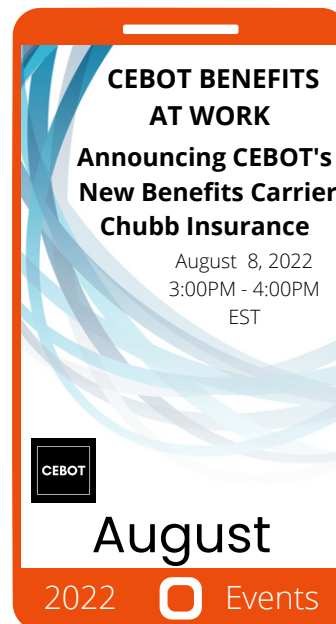
