CEBOT's registered minority technology members already benefit society. Through market research CEBOT has identified 2,637 member companies who are largest in size based on the number of employees (this cohort has 9 or more employees). These top U.S. minority tech employers produce over \$20 billion in sales while employing 145,569 people in high growth, high demand jobs.

Industry crowdsourcing is underway to directly speak to this research cohort in an effort to reduce risk and create new and profitable contracts that bring new jobs to minority.
