Priority Issues

Issues	Summary of feedback
Strategic merit	 The appropriateness of Scotts Head as a location for an over-55s lifestyle community The proportionality of the proposal given the existing footprint and population of Scotts Head The need for any project to be a net positive to the social, economic and environmental fabric of Scotts Head
Medical services	 The existing challenge of accessing GP services - both in Scotts Head, and the surrounding region Difficulties in accessing telehealth, allied professional and specialist services
Funding for services and infrastructure	 Concerns around the share of rates returned to services and infrastructure in Scotts Head There is a need to make an infrastructure contribution to specifically benefit Scotts Head to reflect its impact Whilst Ingenia pays rates as the ongoing landowner, there is a lack of clarity over how this will flow back to the local community and infrastructure needs rather than the wider council area
Design and construction	 A clear commitment is needed that if the project proceeds, good design would follow and the homes would be constructed on site (and not pre-fabricated) - creating local jobs during construction and ongoing operation
Housing affordability	 The relative price of Ingenia's product compared to local and regional house prices and how this changes the existing affordability issue The limitation of access to over-55s when Scotts Head needs more housing for young people
Community contribution	 Ingenia's capacity to support, rather than compete with, existing community assets and facilities Solutions that support the lifestyle community's integration with the existing community



Issues	Summary of feedback
Roads, Traffic and Parking	 The main road connecting Scotts Head to Macksville and beyond has existing shortfalls Scotts Head Rd is flood prone The lack of existing walking and cycling links between the proposed site and main village Car parking near the main beach and shops is inadequate Ingenia should consider a community bus
Water and sewage services and infrastructure	The existing infrastructure is seen as near capacity and struggling to cope during peak holiday periods.
Bushfire and flood risk	 Severe weather events in the past three years posed substantial risks to Scotts Head Evacuation from the site would need to be carefully considered in the event of an emergency Evacuation requirements for the site need to be managed against demands and needs from existing residents, and capacity of volunteer services
Cultural heritage	 Scotts Head has a rich Aboriginal cultural heritage that needs to be respected Discussion of the proposal with the Traditional Owners is important
Environmental and sustainability outcomes	 The biodiversity agreement to conserve land west of Ingenia's own site needs to be permanent and robust Ingenia could explore further opportunities to enhance conservation outcomes and support existing nature-based walking trails Residents are seeking specific commitments on the proposed sustainability features of the proposal
Economic outcomes	 Access to and support for regionally-based trades during construction and operational maintenance Employment opportunities during the operational phase Improvements to telecommunications capacity sought

Over the coming weeks and beyond, Ingenia Lifestyle will be continuing its work to engage with the community, further understand issues and develop specific responses.

This will include:

- Advancing an extensive range of technical studies across including biodiversity, water, sewage, traffic, cultural, visual and social impact assessments
- Providing a dedicated opportunity for representatives of the Scotts Head community to
 speak directly with the Social Impact Assessment Consultant being engaged on the project
- **Continuing our outreach** to community members, critical stakeholders and other people who can help inform our thinking and enhance our design solutions.
