Dr. Shilpak Ambule joined the Indian Foreign Service in 2002 and specialised in the Chinese language, spending eight years at the Indian Embassy in Beijing. During this time, he held various diplomatic roles, including Third Secretary, Second Secretary, First Secretary (Political Wing), and Chief of Staff to the Ambassador.

He later served at the Ministry of External Affairs Headquarters as Deputy Head of the East Asia Division and, from January 2015 to August 2018, as Chief of Staff to the Indian Foreign Secretary. His subsequent assignments included Deputy High Commissioner of India in Colombo (2018–2019), Joint Secretary in the External Affairs Minister's Office (2019–2022), and Joint Secretary (East Asia) from June 2022 to July 2023, where he held dual charge until July 2023.

On 23 July 2023, Dr. Ambule assumed his current role as High Commissioner of India to Singapore. Dr Ambule is married to Mayuri, and they have two daughters.
