Foward-Looking Statement

From The Jobberman Ghana Team

The job market is evolving rapidly. We are seeing changing demographics of job seekers, IT skills becoming essential and a huge demand for tech-related and analytical thinking skills keeps growing; while technology remains a key disruptor.

The supply of labour currently outweighs the demand by employers in Ghana's job market. Despite government policies and other initiatives by donor organisations, growth in corporate and SME (entrepreneurial), establishments do not match the average number of graduates who join the labour supply in the market annually. The recent banking and financial sector crisis leading to over 451 institutions shutting down and tens of thousands of employees being unemployed is also impacting the increase in labour supply.

These have culminated in a very competitive labour market for job seekers, and provided recruiters with the ability to choose and negotiate favourable remuneration packages. Job seekers must continually develop themselves to upskill and acquire other soft skills which could be their competitive advantage in the competitive labour market. The impact of the current digital and information age is greatly influencing job functions and skills in the Ghanaian job market. Every job function requires some level of IT skill set. Recruiters are also getting sophisticated and preferring younger experienced talents with the right behavioural traits.

Going forward, manufacturing is one of the industries that will be the biggest drivers in the Chanaian job market, due to the government's policy to facilitate the establishment of a factory in every district in Ghana. In addition, the top job function generally required by the Job market is IT & Software, and developing a pool of highly skilled professionals in this space is vital, for the job market to grow in Ghana.

Statement from Jobberman Head of Sales, Samuel Incoom

There's an excess supply of trained and qualified candidates within the Ghanaian market, returnee skilled workers, the growing population of highly skilled other nationals living in Ghana who are readily available to take up roles has made the Ghanaian job market very competitive. This sometimes places job seekers on an edge during negotiations over conditions of service and provides recruiters with an upper hand in selecting and negotiating the compensation packages.

The key factors & trends influencing the nature of salaries in Ghana's job market include the general economic outlook e.g inflation of the country; people's quest to better their living conditions; offers being made by other competing firms in industry for similar roles; offers being made to employees in the same group of companies in similar roles in different operating countries and years of experience and competence; and negotiations between labour unions and employers (standing joint negotiating committee of companies - especially public sector).

That said, jobs involving admin, applications/ software developers, business development, marketing, sales and blue collar roles are the most sought-after roles. Furthermore, medical, applications/software developers, blue collar roles as well as roles that require bi-lingual skills are the most challenging roles to fill.

What Is This Report?

The Jobberman Ghana Salary Report contains salary insights in Ghana for the year 2019. The information is extracted from Jobberman's database.

Methodology

To generate this report, we picked the top ten job functions with the most job listings. Out of the top ten job functions, we identified the top six industries with the most applications for each job function.

We then looked at the identified top six industries with the most applications versus how well they pay.

We finally compiled the results to produce insights of pay ranking for major job functions in major industries.

Research entails a detailed study of a subject that involves gathering information and for the advancement of knowledge, while Teaching and Training as a role is to facilitate the acquisition of knowledge, or development of skills.

Expert Insights

While there are a lot of job listings in this space, and a decent amount of profiles that fit this job function (about **6.22%** of our database), the application volumes are low (with an average of **27** qualified applicants per vacancy) despite being the 3rd most viewed job function category (about **78K** pageviews in the last year).

This indicates that there are not enough available professionals in the Research, Teaching and Training space.

Expert Insights

Administrative & Office makes up 11.40% of applicant profiles on our database, and is the second most engaged function with over 179K views. It is also quite a high demand function with an average of 124 highly qualified applicants per vacancy.

This contradicts with the 'WEF Future of Jobs Report' statement that this is one of the top 10 declining roles globally, most likely due to the fact that Ghana is experiencing a boom in new businesses, which need Admin and support roles to function.

Expert Insights

Engineering makes up a significant portion of applicant profiles on our database (about **8.12%**) and is the third most engaged function with over **76K** views. It also has quite a low application volume (an average of **25** qualified applicants per vacancy).

As manufacturing is one of the industries that will be the biggest drivers in the Ghanaian job market, this means that there are not enough qualified engineers to fill the roles that are becoming available.

Accounting, Auditing & Finance makes up 13,44% of applicant profiles on our database, and is the most engaged function with over 183K views. In addition, it is a very high demand function with an average of 122 qualified applicants per vacancy.

This contradicts with the 'WEF Future of Jobs Report' statement that this is one of the top 10 declining roles globally, most likely due to the fact that Ghana is experiencing a boom in new businesses, which need Accounting roles to function.

Expert Insights

Management & Business Development makes up 6.77% of applicant profiles on our database, with an engagement of over 21K views. It is a high demand function with an average of 75 qualified applicants per vacancy.

This high demand could be due to the need for Management & Business Development expertise for Ghanaian businesses to move forward, while dominating their current market and establishing themselves in new markets.

As tech-related functions are needed for the job market to grow in Ghana; this means that there are not enough qualified IT & Software professionals to fill the roles that are becoming available, yet the 'WEF Future of Jobs Report' says IT is one of the top 10 emerging roles globally.

Sales makes up 0.32% of applicant profiles on our database and has an engagement of over 30K views. Furthermore, it is a low demand function with an average of **39** qualified applicants per vacancy.

It's clear that there are not enough sales professionals to fill the roles that are becoming available, despite sales being the heart of any business, and one of the most sought-after roles in the Ghanaian job
