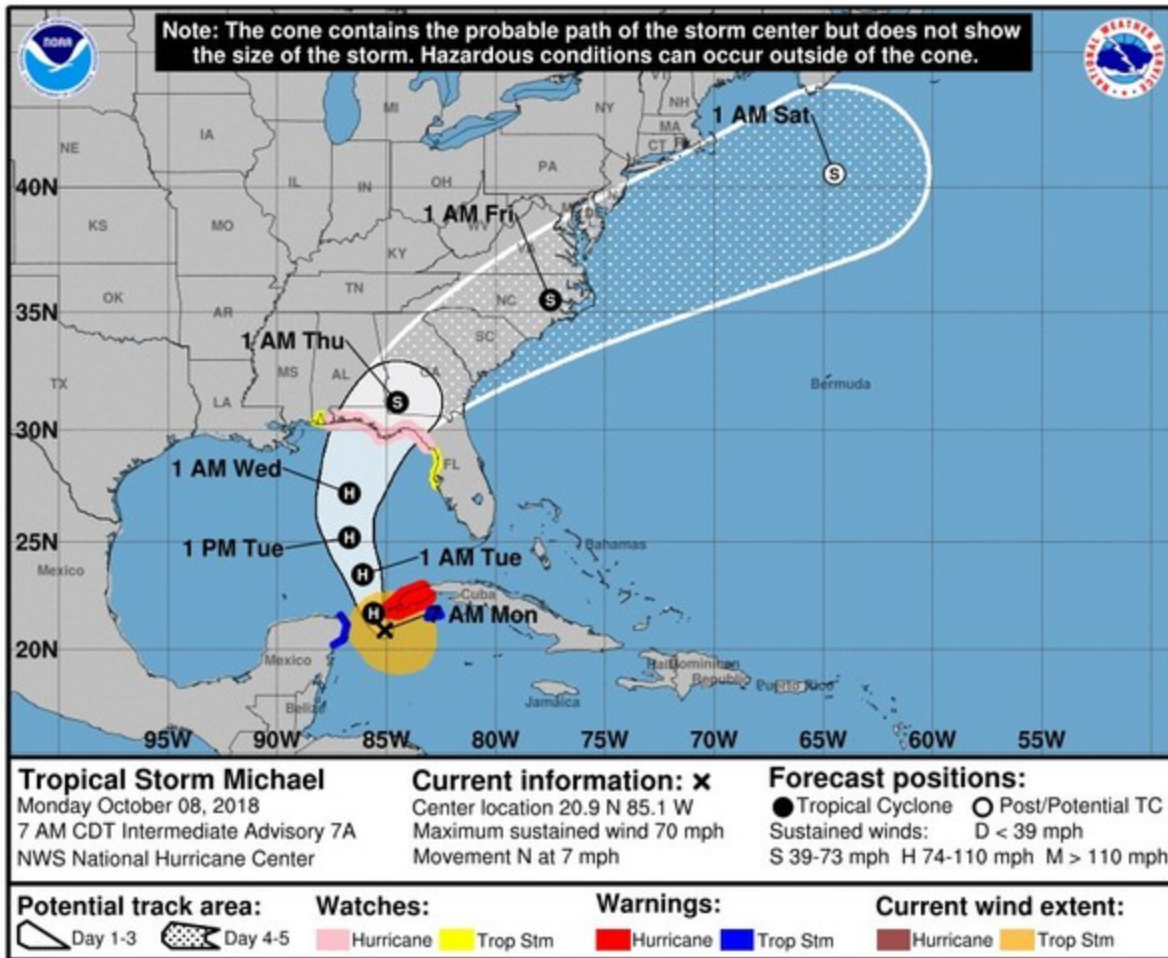

The hurricane is expected to intensify overnight before making landfall. Mandatory evacuations have been issued for parts of the Florida panhandle and AL coast. Landfall is expected tomorrow morning. I'll be down in Sarasota, FL next Friday for a weekend trip so I will miss the storm *thank god*. Any who, Please see the latest updates and tips for handling the hurricane.

- Hurricane Michael
 - Currently north of Cuba sitting in the Gulf building up to likely be a CAT 3 when it hits tomorrow
 - Current projections have Michael moving through Georgia from Southwest to Northeast into the Carolinas and back out to the Atlantic by Friday
 - Please check with your locations in these states to make sure they are open MS, AL, FL, GA, SC, and NC
 - We expect delays and capacity shortages throughout these states
 - We expect most LTL hubs along the coast will shut down but do not have a list as of yet
 - In the wake of the storm we will see rates surge and capacity dry up. As the relief efforts start this will divert capacity from other regions
