Snowfall Impact - Washington/Oregon

Update on snowfall impact on operations in the pacific northwest:

- Auburn, WA - limited operations in outlying areas.
- Mt. Vernon, WA - closed due to excessive snow / road conditions.
- Bremerton, WA - closed due to excessive snow / road conditions.
- Olympia, WA - limited operations in outlying areas.
- Portland, OR - not servicing Columbia River Gorge due to road closures.

Also, with the mountain passes closed all night between Western and Eastern Washington, many routes were not able to run. We will continue to monitor when roads will open and try to get all freight positioned to service as soon as possible.
