## **Weather Update - All Areas**

Update on service impacts due to weather.

We had some relief with reduced snowfall in the Pacific Northwest yesterday. Currently our main interstates are open. We are working diligently to move the backlog of freight between Oregon and Western WA to Eastern WA and Idaho. We are quickly catching up on freight moving between CA and the PNW via I-5. There is still a significant amount of freight to move in many lanes and accomplishing this over the next few days is our priority. There is potential for more weather events later today which could impact I-90 and I-84 again.

Local pickup and delivery operations are attempting to deliver as much freight as possible today. Trouble spots are in WA north of Bellingham, Redding CA area due to power outages and road closures, and the Columbia Gorge east of Portland due to poor road conditions including freezing rain potential.

We sincerely appreciate your patience and understanding during these severe weather conditions.
