**Subject:** Hurricane Update

*Here is the latest update and our current plan for today Tuesday 9-3-2019 & subject to change*

West Palm Beach- Closed. Most of the WPB area is being evacuated and there is a current hurricane warning.

Fort Lauderdale- Coastal areas are being evacuated. We plan a delayed start. We will run central and south of the service center if the hurricane moves north as expected.

Miami- opening [at 4 AM](#) with a small crew. Will send everything south of the service center early. Miami port is closed so we will have some freight forwarders closed as well. We do hope to run a normal operation.

Orlando- Everything coastal is evacuated. We expect heavy closures to the east and around the Orlando area. CLOSED. We are going to have a delayed start but that will depend on the storm and winds. We will not run the coastal areas. Currently Orlando is under a tropical storm warning.

Ocala- Close to 100% on Tuesday.

Tampa - 100% operational on Tuesday.

Fort Myers- 100% operational on Tuesday.

Jacksonville- CLOSED multiple evacuations and a lot of closures. We will evaluate [at 7:30pm](#) and [at 8am](#). There is a high probability we will not get much done (if anything) in Jacksonville on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Valdosta- 100% operational on Tuesday.

Savannah- multiple evacuations areas. Will evaluate [at 7:30PM](#) and [8AM](#). Multiple road closures along with reverse traffic flow on major interstates. We will not run south towards St Simons Island or Brunswick GA. We do hope to deliver some limited areas tomorrow.
