Subject: Hurricane Dorian Update August 30, 2019

Hurricane Dorian continues to build strength and was moving closer to the Florida coast but has since turned toward the Carolinas. While the exact point and time of landfall is not certain, we do know this storm will have significant impact on our areas. It is projected to make landfall as a Category 4 Hurricane (approx. 140 mph winds) early Tuesday morning.

We ran a normal Linehaul operation last night and the focus was moving all inbound loads, or as many as feasible, to arrive to Florida and south Georgia destinations this morning, which will allow those service centers to work Saturday inbound operations. Upon completion of inbound, each will prepare for the incoming storm per Hurricane Procedures. No Linehaul will run in or out of these locations over the holiday weekend. As always, our first priority is the safety of our people.

We will provide additional updates on Tuesday after the storm makes landfall. Please keep those in Dorian's path in your thoughts and prayers.
