Below is a quick update for those interested in transportation related updates/closures and what they mean to you and your business:

Currently, all major LTL (Less-than-Truckload) and Truckload carriers are open for business. With respect to “shelter-in-place” locations, most manufacturers are considered essential at this point. Some companies are choosing to close or have unions that are making that decision for them, but the general feedback from the thousands of shippers we are picking up from each day is that they are electing to remain open, if possible. Transportation services are deemed to be essential up to this point.

Below are the areas that are experiencing “shelter-in-place” that have impacted transportation services with the exception of business deemed essential:

- California
- Connecticut
- Delaware
- Illinois
- Louisiana

- Parts of Missouri
- New Jersey
- New York
- Ohio
- Wisconsin

We do expect, and have seen an increase in full truckload and expedite moves to protect the supplies of customers. Please contact me directly if you have any questions. Additionally, our carrier partners have asked that shippers contact their customers to ensure that they intend on being open and can receive the freight prior to shipping in order to keep the supply chain as clean as possible.
