Morning All,

We hope that you are all safe and healthy. A majority of States now have “shelter-in-place” or “safer-at-home” rules in place for at least part of the State or its entirety. There is a list below of States that have yet to put those rules in place. Most manufacturers continue to be considered “essential” and are operational.

Some LTL carriers have begun waiving money-back guarantee services. Those that have, will continue to prioritize freight marked “guaranteed” in their networks, but will no longer be offering reimbursement.

With that being said, all LTL carriers are running and operational and we haven’t seen any unusual service related issues overall. Thank you for continuing to validate that consignees are receiving prior to shipping whenever possible to keep the supply chain clean and avoid congesting the network with undeliverable freight.

There are currently no major disruptions regarding Truckload carriers and they continue to move freight across the US and Canada without issue. If you have

any freight that needs special care (expedite, storage, etc), please let us know as we have many options available.
