Subject: Control Measures for Chinese Exports of Medical Equipment

Due to the spread of COVID-19, the Government of China has issued a statement regarding export controls of certain medical equipment that includes ventilators, masks, gowns, thermometers, and diagnostic kits.

Control measures that include the following will be imposed starting April 1:

1. The exporting company must provide a written or electronic declaration confirming that the product has obtained China's medical device product registration certificate.
2. Certification must also declare that the product meets the quality standards of the importing country.
3. Customs in China will then inspect and validate the export paperwork in conjunction with the certificate.

Depending on the development of the virus, export requirements will be

adjusted as needed.
