Good morning. Germany easing some restrictions.

CHINA

UPS (Non-Mask Shipment):

South China to US GWT at 200kg (440lbs) for Export PP and 300kg (660lbs) for Export FC.

East China (PVG / Shanghai) to US GWT at 300kg (660lbs) for both Export PP and Export FC.

Effective April 18, 2020, UPS requires all shipments containing 12 categories of medical supply commodities (non-medical or medical per listed in GAC5 and GAC53) to be processed as Formal Entry for export customs clearance. Further, with immediate effect, China's Ministry of Commerce, Customs and National Medical Products Administration require all shippers exporting these 12 categories of medical supply commodities to provide the following documentation for export customs clearance:

a) *Export Medical Supplies Statement, provided by the Exporter of Record (EOR); and*

b) *Medical Device Product Registration Certificate, issued by the National Medical Products Administration to the manufacturer*

Tunisia-Coronavirus

On March 21 2020 ,The Tunisian Government decided to put the country on a total lockdown from March 22, originally until April 4 2020. This has now been extended until 4 May 2020.

Leaving homes requires permission of local authorities-critical business, such as supermarkets, medical facilities are exempted from the requirement.

The President of Tunisia suspended all passenger flights. Charter crews are not allowed to disembark, resulting in a quicker turnaround. UPS continue to import and export volume-however, import not changed while export is delayed by 24 hours.

All deliveries must be completed by 15.30.
