The state of emergency which started from Tuesday March 17 2020 in Bosnia and Herzegovina as a prevention measure of COVID 19 has been amended.

From May 15 2020, more restrictions were lifted but still special precautions have to be undertaken. These uplifted restrictions are:

Elders of age over 65 years and youth up to 18 years may from today move freely without restrictions-Public transportation is gradually getting back to normal-Hotels, restaurants, bars & coffee shops are open-Hairdressing salons and dental clinics are also open.

If the consignee address is closed, packages will be returned to the shipper.

From 1 June 2020, Sarajevo Airport has been officially opened. At the moment, only a few charter flights are operating (including UPS) and first commercial flight is expected on June 4th. Also, the export flight to Ljubljana, Slovenia is back to pre-COVID 19 schedule.

Further to the lockdown in India that started on 23 March 2020, the Government of India on 31 May, announced relaxations beginning 8 June except in areas designated as containment zones.
