

Montessori Together (6 months to 24 months)

This accompanied Montessori-inspired playgroup offers infants and young toddlers the opportunity to freely explore our prepared environment and engage with curated Montessori materials. Supported by trained teachers, each child in our Montessori Together program grows to become a self-initiated learner and independent thinker ready to succeed both inside and outside of the classroom.



Transitional Toddler (2 to 3 years)

This unaccompanied Montessori-inspired program builds the confidence in young toddlers to independently explore the world around them. During the class, young toddlers try new things and engage with curated Montessori materials while our trained teachers provide them with freedom and time to do things on their own while remaining close by to support and encourage self-initiated learning. Classes seamlessly integrate music and art activities to entice even the most reserved child to engage in learning.

Natural Science (3 to 6 years)

This program raises within a young child an awareness of the interdependence of all things. From this awareness stems a deep sense of respect and gratitude towards the world. Classes incorporate exploration and experimentation with hands-on materials in the scientific fields of Botany, Zoology and Geography. Through this program, children develop an understanding and confidence within themselves, and develop a sense of respect and gratitude towards the natural world.



Sensory Math (3 to 6 years)

Children experience the wonder of math through engaging materials that inspire concrete understanding and joyful problem-solving which paves the way for a smooth transition to abstraction. They are exposed to rich and varied sensorial materials that build math skills gradually, laying a solid foundation for a lifetime of quantitative and analytic fluency.

English Literacy Arts (3 to 6 years)

Literacy arts breaks down language learning into clear component skills which helps make language learning effortless. This program is designed to build the foundation for English literacy that leads to an explosion to language, allowing each child to experience reading and writing with joy. Through our approach to literacy arts, children become confident communicators.

Creative Arts (3 to 6 years)

A transformative creative arts program designed for young children. Through focused, small-group sessions, children learn to confidently express their authentic self in a safe and nurturing environment. Children will have plenty of opportunity to engage in process-focused art experiences, such as storytelling, painting, music and movement, which culminates in developing learners who are confident in themselves and their abilities.

Workshops are designed to develop parents' confidence in a variety of areas and support the entire parenting journey.


