Ranked in Top 5 in Overall Conditioning in the United States, The Quarry at La Quinta is dramatically nestled at the base of the foothills between the Coral and the Santa Rosa Mountains. Renowned golf course architect, Tom Fazio, masterfully designed what is referred to as the "Golfer's Golf Course." By harnessing the three unique elevations offered by the site, he created three very distinct playing areas, as golfers will encounter a gradual elevation of more than 300 feet. The clubhouse features awe-inspiring views of the course and the surrounding mountains. There is also a health spa, tennis court and luxurious accommodations for Members and their guests, as well as private dining.

In 2002, an additional 74 acres were purchased and became the site of 29 new pieces of real estate and the Tom Fazio-designed Short Course, a 10-hole practice facility. The area was named Quarry Ranch.

The Championship Course

The Championship Course includes many elements - a lush scenery of indigenous plants, an abandoned western mine and a number of bronze statues depicting the early cowboy days. It's a harmonious union of golf and nature. It's an example of how Tom Fazio sees existing conditions to create interest yet maintains playability for golfers of different ability levels. Fazio also left the greens open in the back, another example designing a playable golf course. Fazio does not like to penalize a bold shot too severely.

The 18-hole Quarry Championship course features 7,083 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72. Members and Guests can enjoy one of five different tee combinations for Men and two different tee combinations for Ladies.

The Short Course

The Tom Fazio designed Short Course, just ranked by Golf Magazine among the Top 25 Short Courses in the World, consists of 10 individually designed Par 3's that vary in distance from 117 yards all the way back to 218 yards. This is not your typical "par 3" Course, it is truly a world class golf experience that will leave you in awe that something considered to be a "Short Course" can be a surprising challenge.

The Short Course is ideal for members to practice their short and mid irons and improve their accuracy. In addition, a large open area allows for the creation of a few par 4's, ranging from 240 to 380.

The Putting Course

Our 18-hole authentic grass Putting Course lends the first glimpse into the caliber of your golf experience. Adjacent to the Short Course, the Putting Course's relaxed atmosphere accommodates all skill levels. On holiday weekends it is the main attraction for families and is great if you are short on time.

- Manage Daily operations of the golf course by starting groups off of Hole #1. Since this facility does not offer tee times, the duty
 of Starter for the assistant professionals is crucial to daily success of the golf department. Actively understand and responsible
 for Jonas tee sheet for proper rounds tracking and billing of guest fees.
- Properly manage pace of play, and communicate with members judiciously to ensure the overall satisfaction of the players each day.
- Assist the Head Professional with Tournament Operations via Golf Genius tournament software.
- Properly operate the point-of-sale system (Jonas), which includes charging and crediting members for merchandise, keeping tabs
 on demo clubs, and ultimately running all closing reports.
- Assist Merchandiser in keeping the shop clean through dusting, vacuuming, folding and straightening out merchandise.
- Answer phones, record golf requests, and assist with all member/guest needs and requests.
- Assist Locker Room Manager with closing procedures, and notifying the Security gate of any information for the next business day.
- Assist with the inventory process and under the guidance of the Director of Golf and the Merchandiser, place special orders, order and receive merchandise.
- Assist the golf staff with instructional clinics and golf instructional programs.
- Oversee and guide the outside service staff, maintaining a high level of customer service by aiding in the attention to detail in everything we offer.

SKILLS AND REQUIREMENTS

- The employee is regularly required to sit and walk. The employee must be able to use hands to finger, handle or feel. The
