Depending on the farm allocated, the farm visit will cover various topics such as;
FORESTRY –machinery, wood cutting, tree-felling and timber extraction.
LIVESTOCK - cattle on display, breed types and a display of different types of feeds: hay, straw, silage etc.
KEEPERS CORNER - a selection of poultry / game birds / eggs
ARABLE – Machinery and its uses, the “Farming Year” starting with the field after the crops.

NOTE: Not all farms cover all topics.

Coach travel is included to and from the venue, lunch is NOT included. The winning school caterer school must organise enough adults to supervise children in line with their school policy and general safeguarding guidelines.

Maximum of 150 pupils of primary school age (4-11), prize must be taken before October 2019.
