Point-of-Collection
Rapid/Field

Finger Stick
(Blood)

Results within
10 minutes

Recommended
when...

Later signs of
infection/suspected
exposure; Detection
window = 3-5 days
symptomatic people;
or 7 days
asymptomatic.

Reported to:
Employer only

\$35 per-person;
\$100 hazard pay

Antigen Instant Test

Point-of-Collection
Rapid/Field

Nasal Swab
(Until resistance is met)

Results within
15 minutes

Recommended
when...

Early signs of
infection/suspected
exposure; within
about 5 days.

Reported to:
Employer &
Dept. of Health

\$65 per-person;
\$100 hazard pay

Antigen Saliva CRL

Lab-Based

Saliva
(Spit Collection)

Results within
48 -72 hours

Recommended
when...

Early signs of
infection/suspected
exposure; within
about 5 days.

Reported to:
Employer &
Dept. of Health

\$170 per-person;
\$100 hazard pay

Antigen Origin Partnership

Lab-Based

Nasal Swab
(Further up into the nose)

Results within
48 -72 hours

Recommended
when...

exposure; within
