OPTIONS

Visa Solutions is looking forward to processing your application for a Green Card. The EB3 Immigrant Visa (Green Card) allows you to include your spouse (legally married) and unmarried children under the age of 21 on your Green Card application.

We want to inform you of the three (3) options available regarding your family.

- Option 1 - Do not include family Members
- Option 2 - Include family members
- Option 3 - Family members to apply and join later

Carefully read the options listed below, and determine which option is best for your family. If you have any questions, please contact your recruiter, or a Visa Solutions representative. Any changes to your final decision may not be feasible and/or will incur additional expenses.

OPTION 1 - DO NOT INCLUDE FAMILY MEMBERS

If you choose Option 1 your family members **WILL NOT** be included in your Green Card application process. **Even if you don't include them, you still are required to include documentation for them.** See page 3, Supporting Documents.

OPTION 2 - INCLUDE FAMILY MEMBERS

If you choose Option 2 your family WILL BE included in your green card application process. You will all go to the USA Consulate interview together and you will all receive your **Green Cards at the same time.** Once you and your family members have received your Green Cards, you will have the following alternatives:

- **Option 2a:** You and your family will travel together to the USA.
- **Option 2b** Travel to the USA by yourself first, then have your family join you within the first 6 months after your arrival. By selecting this option you will have the time to settle into your new job and place of residence. This option may allow for an easier transition for your family members when they arrive. Family members must travel to the USA **within six (6) months after** approval of their Green Card or their Green Card will be cancelled.

OPTION 3 - FAMILY MEMBERS TO APPLY AND JOIN LATER

If you choose Option 3: your family WILL BE included in your Green Card application process but their Green Cards will not be processed until later when you are in the USA. Once your application is approved, only you will be required to attend the USA Consulate interview and **only you will receive a Green Card at that time.**

Once you arrive in the USA and settle into your new job, you may then contact us and request that we start the "Follow to Join" process for your family members. This process can be initiated at any time within the first twelve (12) months of your arrival in the USA. The "Follow to Join" Green Card approval time varies, but is currently taking approximately four (4) months from the time we initiate the request. Your family members will be required to attend the USA Consulate interview to receive their Green Cards.

You do not need to be present at the USA Consulate during your family's interview.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Original or certified copies of birth certificates for all children of the principal applicant (even if he or she is not accompanying).
- If you are legally married: Your original Marriage Certificate(s). (South Africa requires an Unabridged version)
- If you were previously married: Your original divorce or spouse's death certificate.
