In line with the connected world that we live in, MSU library provides on-line access to thousands of journals and electronic books. Users can access, download or print the journal articles or books via the MSU Student Portal. Through our online facility, users will be able to retrieve more than 130,000 e-books and thousands of journal articles in various disciplines or subjects. For those who prefer to peruse through traditional books, the MSU library currently holds more than 30,000 books.

MSU library is fully automated and our computerized Library Management Utility, will provide users with information about what is held in the collections and what has been borrowed, and also allow selfreservations and renewal of borrowings. Users can also do their own searching and status checking via the OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog).
